WHEREAS, Madera County intends to apply for grant funding from the California State Library for the North Fork Library Safety and Accessibility Upgrades.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Madera, that:

1. Pursuant and subject to all of the terms and provisions of the California Budget Act of 2021, County Administrative Officer, or designee, is hereby authorized and directed to prepare and file an application for funding with the California State Library and take such other actions necessary or appropriate to obtain grant funding.

2. The County Administrative Officer, or designee, is hereby authorized and directed to execute the funding agreement with the California State Library and any amendments thereto.

3. The County Administrative Officer, or designee, is hereby authorized and directed to submit any required documents, funding requests, and reports required to obtain grant funding.

4. The County hereby certifies that the project will comply with any laws and regulations including, but not limited to, the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), legal requirements for building codes, health and safety codes, the California Labor Code, disabled access laws, and that prior to commencement of the project, all applicable permits will have been obtained.
