DISCUSSION / FISCAL IMPACT / STRATEGIC FOCUS:

DISCUSSION:

Madera County Library (MCL) was one of ten libraries in California to participate in the Community Connections grant and community of practice through the California State Library in FY 2021-22 (AIS #7823). The grant provided funds and support to create community resource hubs in each library location, plus staffing of the hub at the Madera Main Library. The resource hubs increase awareness of local information and services by providing current, relevant, and trusted resources and connecting patrons with appropriate partnering organizations. MCL has the opportunity to continue the collaboration with Oceanside and Glendale Libraries, with additional grant funds to further support staffing of community resource hubs. Grant funds up to \$44,407 will be distributed via reimbursements from CALIFA, the fiscal agent for the project. This

specific funding will support the continued subscription to SpringShare's LibCal, an online calendar platform that allows MCL to increase awareness of community events while also providing an avenue for the Community Resource Specialists to book individual appointments with patrons.
