RECOMMENDED ACTIONS:

Consideration of entering into an Agreement (State Agreement No. 1341-CVSPH-2022-MC) with the California Mental Health Services Authority (CalMHSA) in the amount of \$48,751.06 for the administration of the Central Valley Suicide Prevention Hotline (CVSPH) for Fiscal Year 2022-2023 and authorize the Chairman to sign.

DISCUSSION / FISCAL IMPACT / STRATEGIC FOCUS:

DISCUSSION:

On October 10, 2010, your Board authorized Behavioral Health Services (BHS) to join the California Mental Health Services Authority (CalMHSA) Joint Powers Authority (JPA) which gave BHS voting privileges regarding decisions to efficiently implement some Mental Health Services Act (MHSA) programming. At the same time, your Board authorized BHS to have the State Department of Mental Health send proposed Statewide Prevention and Early Intervention (PEI) funds to the CalMHSA JPA to develop statewide PEI projects. CalMHSA eventually contracted with Kings View to develop the Central Valley Suicide Prevention Hotline (CVSPH).



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The CVSPH is administered through CaIMHSA on behalf of the counties that are participating in and funding the program. The CVSPH serves as the primary suicide prevention hotline for these counties. As funding allows, CVSPH will continue to operate a 24/7 suicide prevention hotline accredited by the American Association of Suicidology and will continue to answer calls through its participation in the National Suicide Prevention Lifeline. CVSPH will also maintain its hotline website and will provide outreach and technical assistance to counties that are participating and funding the program.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The cost of this contract is paid with MHSA PEI funding. There is no impact to the County General Fund.

CONNECTION TO THE COUNTY OF MADERA STRATEGIC PLAN - MISSION 2023:

This agreement meets the above selected Strategic Focus Areas by providing mental health services by acting as the primary suicide prevention hotline for Madera County.
