DISCUSSION / FISCAL IMPACT / STRATEGIC FOCUS:

DISCUSSION:

This is the final reimbursement for Madera County Library's Backpack Literacy Program, that offered early literacy workshops in English and Spanish for parents and caregivers of young children. The purpose of the project was to support parents and caregivers in being their children's first teacher, and to supply corresponding materials via early literacy backpack kits to participants. As their children's first teacher, informal child care providers may lack the tools and support to properly prepare young children for kindergarten readiness. Children that start school behind their peers can have a hard time catching up and keeping up, and the achievement gap can grow. The Library was able to expand its reach beyond physical buildings and spread awareness and action surrounding early literacy further in our rural and unincorporated areas.
