RECOMMENDED ACTIONS:

Employment Development Department Data Access.

1. Consideration to adopt a Resolution approving and authorizing the execution of the Standard Agreement with the California Department of Social Services for access to Employment Development Department confidential data.
2. Consideration of entering into an Agreement (State Agreement No. 22-1006) with the California Department of Social Services to access Employment Development Department base wage data from July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2025 and authorize the Chairman to sign.

DISCUSSION / FISCAL IMPACT / STRATEGIC FOCUS:

CDSS has an established partnership with EDD to obtain wage data and Unemployment Insurance (UI) benefit payment history. This Agreement allows the Madera County Department of Social Services to receive access to quarterly EDD base wage data to understand labor market participation of CalWORKs, CalFresh Employment & Training and General Assistance program clients, while following security and confidentiality requirements.



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Matching client data with quarterly wages provides employment and earnings data that



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may be tracked over time for specific groups of program clients. Currently, Department data does not provide any information on employment or earnings of program recipients. Several files produced by EDD are the only source allows accessibility to track the employment and earnings of welfare program recipients after leaving public assistance as well as unemployment and disability payments. Ultimately, the data will allow the Department to measure the effectiveness of Employment Services programs in Madera County.

FISCAL IMPACT: There is no additional increase to the Net County Cost associated with the recommended action. This is a no-cost Agreement and does not have an impact on the County General Fund.
