#### **RECOMMENDED ACTIONS:**

Discussion and consideration of entering into an Agreement by and between Groveland Development Corporation, Riverstone Development, LLC, Lennar Homes of California, LLC, and the County of Madera for the funding and reimbursement of the design, engineering, and construction of the full build of Avenue 12 from State Route 41 through the Road 40 intersection and authorize the Chairman to sign.

### DISCUSSION / FISCAL IMPACT / STRATEGIC FOCUS:

#### **DISCUSSION:**

This agreement requires that the Riverstone Development and Lennar Homes of California fully fund the buildout of Avenue 12 along their property frontage. That construction would result in ultimately an eight-lane facility between State Route 41 and Riverwalk Boulevard. Avenue 12 would then transition to a six-lane facility west of Riverwalk Boulevard and ultimately to a four-lane facility through Road 40. The



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agreement requires Riverstone Development and Lennar Homes to fund the complete cost of all project requirements and would then be subject to full reimbursement from the Road Impact Fee Program once State Route 41 is improved to a four-lane facility north of Avenue 12. The agreement does require an initial reimbursement of \$3,000,000 from Road Impact Fees paid within the development boundaries to be divided between Riverstone and Lennar at the time the Avenue 12 expansion is open to traffic, no additional reimbursement would occur until State Route 41 is improved to a four-lane facility north of Avenue 12.

To avoid overlapping, redundant, and/or inconsistent work, the County has determined that the most efficient method of widening SR 41 is to undertake an integrated project that includes the SR 41 Project along with the continued widening of SR 41 north from the Avenue 12 and Highway 41 Intersection to just north of Avenue 15. The County, in coordination with Caltrans, has completed its environmental review of the Project; identified funding sources, is approaching sixty percent (60%) completion of the construction documents and anticipates commencing construction in calendar year 2024.

The Avenue 12 Project's Street improvements and transition lanes are necessary to mitigate regional impacts arising from existing and new development within Madera County.

The developers included in the agreement consider the Avenue 12 Project to be of mutual benefit and are willing to advance certain costs. The parties have reached an agreement subject to the terms and conditions of the Funding and Reimbursement Agreement.

#### FISCAL IMPACT:

Funding Sources primarily consist of fees collected by the County from within the Riverstone Development through its Road Impact Fees and the Riverstone Enhanced Infrastructure Financing District Funds.
