#### **RECOMMENDED ACTIONS:**

Discussion and consideration of entering into an Agreement with Lozano Smith, LLP, for legal services at a rate for attorneys not to exceed \$260.00 per hour and law clerks and paralegals not to exceed \$150.00 per hour in connection with litigation and similar services for a three-year term and authorize the Chairman to sign.

### **DISCUSSION / FISCAL IMPACT / STRATEGIC FOCUS:**

Lozano Smith, LLP has been contracted to provide legal services to Madera County since September 23, 2014. Since that time, attorney Regina Garza has served as County Counsel. In addition to providing all services associated with the office of the County Counsel, Lozano Smith has served as defense counsel representing the County in various litigated matters.

In July 2015, it was mutually agreed between Lozano Smith and the County, that litigation services provided by the firm would be the subject of a separate legal services agreement to allow for monitoring and control of these specialized services. The most recent agreement, MCC NO. 11568-20, is set to expire January 14, 2023. Approval of

the proposed agreement will allow Lozano Smith to continue to serve as litigation counsel for the County. As is the case with other firms contracted to provide litigation services to the County, cases assigned to Lozano Smith are subject to referral by your Board, the County Claims Review Committee or the Deputy CAO overseeing Risk Management and Legal Services. The County Counsel does not participate in the referral of cases to Lozano Smith.

Terms of the proposed agreement are consistent with the expiring agreement; however, the proposed agreement includes an increase in hourly rate from \$220 per hour to \$260 per hour. Costs associated with this agreement are partially paid from the General Liability Trust.
